1. RULES

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing – [Windsurfing Edition](#) (WCR).
- 1.2. The [T293 Class Rules](#) & Championship Rules will apply to the Techno 293 (Junior and Youth) European Championships (**T293**).
- 1.3. No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.5. If there is a conflict between these Sailing Instructions and any other document governing the event, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
This changes WCR 63.7.
- 1.6. Every competitor will be required to carry on their person, not attached to their equipment, a tracking device supplied by the organisation during every race.

2. ADVERTISING

Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. World Sailing Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' shall apply.

3. CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

- 3.1. The participating classes and divisions shall be:
 - 3.1.1 **Techno 293 (T293)** - Junior Boy & Girl; Youth Boy & Girl
- 3.2. **Age Divisions:**
 - 3.2.1. A **T293 Junior** shall be under 15 years of age (born in 2006, but not later than 2010).
 - 3.2.2. A **T293 Youth** shall be under 17 years of age (born in 2004 but not later than 2008).
- 3.3 A minimum of 5 competitors is required to constitute a division.
- 3.4 **Age Sub-Divisions:**
 - 3.4.1 T293 U13 shall be under 13 years of age (born in 2008, but not later than 2010).

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. All entries shall meet the requirements of WS Regulation 19-Eligibility Code.
- 4.2. Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a paid up member of the relevant international class association, or of the IWA. Membership formalities can be completed on site.
- 4.3. Eligible competitors may [enter online](#) - credit/debit card or bank transfer payment required. **Online entry will close on 16th August 2020.**
- 4.4. A competitor entry is not valid until the entry fee is paid.
- 4.5. The following shall be presented upon registration:
 - ☐ Evidence of valid third party insurance
 - ☐ Proof of age
 - ☐ [Parental Permission Form](#) - *for those under age of 18*
- 4.6. Coaches and support personnel may [register online](#) - credit/debit card or bank transfer payment required.
The following shall be presented upon registration:
 - ☐ Boat Driving Licence (if applicable)
 - ☐ Evidence of valid third party insurance

5. ENTRY FEES

- 5.1. The required entry fees are - 220 euro.
- 5.2. Competitor entry fees paid by **26th July** shall receive a **40 euro discount**.
- 5.3. Late competitor entries accepted at registration shall incur late entry fee of 20 euro.
- 5.4. A fee of 50 euro is required for coaches and support personnel.
- 5.5. Entry fees paid at registration shall be paid in cash - Euros.

6. RACE FORMAT

- 6.1. The Championship shall be a *racing*, "open entry" event.
- 6.2. Men and women, boys and girls may race together depending upon entry numbers.
- 6.3. The **T293** Class may race a maximum 4 races a day, in a maximum 15 race event.
- 6.4. Three races are required to validate the championship for each class.

7. SCHEDULE

7.1.

- 7.2. The daily race schedule and the scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race will be posted on the Official Notice board, except on the 24th August when the first warning signal for a practice race will be made at 14:00.

8. EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 8.1. An Equipment Inspection Form shall be completed and returned to the Event Equipment Inspectors by the close of registration.
- 8.2. Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.
- 8.3. Upon completion of registration and until the end of the event, at all times when ashore except when launching and retrieving, all equipment shall be kept in their assigned places at event site. Removal of any equipment from the event site requires prior written approval from the race committee. Access to equipment in the storage area during certain hours, including hours of darkness may be restricted.
- 8.4. Unless otherwise directed by the organizing authority, boards and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the designated area at the event site.
- 8.5. Each racing day every competitor will be issued with a tracking device, which shall be returned to the distribution desk as specified in the Sis.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available no later than at event registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Class Representative at the event.

10. COURSES

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

11. INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury will be appointed in accordance with WCR Appendix N. There shall be no appeal from their decisions in accordance with WCR 70.5.

12. SCORING

Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A. Championship Rules apply when Group Racing within divisions.

13. COACHES AND SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered at the race office. Support boat drivers shall have a valid boat licence and third party liability insurance. Charter is available and may be applied for – full details on event website.

14. SAFETY

- 14.1. Personal buoyancy is mandatory for every competitor and support boat crewmember.
- 14.2. Every competitor and support boat crew member shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), **This changes WCR 40.**

15. PRIZES

- 15.1. Prizes will be awarded to the first three competitors of each properly constituted class /division.
- 15.2. The first **T293 Junior** boy and girl shall be known as the – **2020 Techno 293 Junior European Champion.**
- 15.3. The first **T293 Youth** boy and girl shall be known as the – **2020 Techno 293 Youth European Champion.**
- 15.4. Winners in the T293 U13 Sub-division shall be decided by their positions in the T293 Junior overall ranking.
- 15.5. European titles shall only be awarded to competitors eligible to compete for an European nation.

16. OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organizing authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion. **Prize winners may forfeit prizes for non attendance at the prize giving ceremony.**

17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 - Decision to Race. The organizing authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

18. INSURANCE

Each participating board shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,500,000 euro per event or the equivalent.

19. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
